### REFEREES NEEDED

We need referees! We currently do not have enough referees to officiate the approximately 60+ soccer teams playing games each weekend for this coming soccer season. Referees are essential and they allow us to offer a safe, fair, and fun experience for every game. A trained and certified referee is needed for every game, and in most cases, we need three referees for the game. To put it simply, if we do not have referees, we cannot play the game. Training and a uniform will be provided for every volunteer who completes the Referee Training Course and officiates games. It is not as scary as it sounds.
