



## **Welcome to Antelope AYSO: Referee!**

To be a qualified Referee, you'll need to complete the steps below.

All trainings and safety steps are required by either the State of California or by AYSO.

Volunteer Form *Required each year	<ul> <li>Sign in to your player's account on AntelopeAYSO.org.</li> <li>Click "Volunteer" or the person icon</li> <li>Click "Find Volunteer Opportunities"</li> <li>Click "Referee"</li> <li>You'll have the option to sign up a "Registered User" or a "New User." If you signed in with your email and you will be the referee, click "Registered User" or if you are signing up another person, click "New User".</li> <li>Click Continue</li> <li>Complete the next form and submit.</li> </ul>
Risk Assessment *Required each year (not required for Youth Referees)	<ul> <li>Click "Risk Status" and deselect any other items</li> <li>Click "Renew and update"</li> <li>Now complete the requested information.</li> <li>This will trigger an email from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party background checking company "Sterling Volunteers." You will need to create an account with them.</li> <li>Check your email address for an email from them and complete the process.</li> <li>You will be asked if you would like to pay the \$25 fee. Please do not pay. Select the other option and Antelope AYSO will pay the fee.</li> </ul>
Concussion Awareness Cardiac Arrest Safe Haven *Required only once	These are online courses. To get to them, you must be logged in with your own email account (if you signed up as a "New User" on the first step, you need to create your own password and log in so everything will save under your account).  • Click the "AYSOU" button (find your name and it should be on the right side)  • Wait while you are transferred to the training website.  • Click "Training Library"  • Find "Safe Haven" and Click "View Courses"  The first 3 courses are the ones you need. Click "Enroll" and complete each course. Your certification should automatically be linked to your AntelopeAYSO.org account, as long as you logged in with your own email address.

Safe Sport (not required for Youth Referees)  90 minute training every 3 years, 30 minute refresher for each year in between Fingerprinting *Required once (not required for Youth Referees)	<ul> <li>This is an anti-bullying and anti-harrassment training.</li> <li>On your AntelopeAYSO.org Volunteer Page, select the "SafeSport" option ONLY. Click Renew and Update.</li> <li>A window will pop up. Use the link, create an account and go through the online training.</li> <li>You can be fingerprinted at a local AYSO event or you can arrange to be fingerprinted on your own.</li> <li>Please email info@antelopeayso.org and request a fingerprint fee waiver code if you cannot make the date after it is announced</li> </ul>
Referee Training  *Required once for each of these levels: a) 6U/8U, b) 10U/12U, c) 14U and up).	You will need to complete the online module and an in-person class. Please try to complete the online course before attending in person.  Go to the Volunteer Page in AntelopeAYSO.org  Click "AYSOU" to the right of your name.  Wait while you are transferred to the training website.  Click "Training Library"  Under "Refereeing" please click "View Courses"  For 6U and 8U, select the course titled "8U Official Course Online"  For 10U and 12U select the course titles "Regional Referee Online + In-Person Companion Course"  You must complete an in-person session in addition to the online course to be qualified  7/13 from 9:00-1:00 @ Clubhouse for all levels  7/15 and 7/16 Field session from 6-7:30 at Tetotem
