

Antelope American Youth Soccer Organization Scholarship 2017

Description and Requirements

The vision of the American Youth Soccer Organization is to provide world-class youth soccer programs that enrich children's lives. We have been accomplishing this for the children of Antelope and the surrounding communities since 1991. We promote a fun, family soccer environment based on the six AYSO philosophies: Everyone Plays, Balanced Teams, Open Registration, Positive Coaching, Good Sportsmanship, Player Development.

The Award

Antelope AYSO is offering up to \$1,000.00 in scholarships to be awarded to graduating seniors based upon meeting the eligibility criteria and the essay. The number of scholarships and amounts to be determined by the committee.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
2. Must be planning to attend a college or a technical or vocational school.
3. Must have played with Antelope AYSO during his or her high school years.

Application Submission Requirements

The application must include a personal statement between 1,000-1,500 words, double-spaced. The prompt can be found at the end of the application.

The application must also include a recommendation from someone who can attest to the applicant's embodiment of the six AYSO Philosophies.

Deadline

Applications must be postmarked and submitted to the Antelope AYSO Scholarship Committee, c/o Antelope AYSO, 7909 Walerga Rd., #112-156, Antelope, CA 95843 no later than February 28, 2017.

Selection and Award Process

The committee will make the final selection by March 31, 2017.

Awardees will receive an awards certificate at a special ceremony at a regular Antelope AYSO meeting or at his or her high school Awards Night.
